

#### Draft Language for Article 5.A.2.f

##### Affiliate Faculty

Faculty that provide substantial curricular, content, or other forms of support for a program outside of their tenure home are eligible for affiliate faculty status in the program. Affiliate faculty shall be considered voting members of the department and will be eligible to be elected or appointed to voting membership on departmental committees, except those committees whose membership is restricted to tenured members of the faculty. Affiliate faculty may not serve on departmental promotion, reappointment, and tenure (personnel) committees, ~~departmental promotion committees,~~ departmental committees developing and approving long-range tenure management plans, and any other committees which the department restricts to tenured members of the faculty. Affiliate faculty may not serve in any administrative roles within the affiliate program, and affiliate faculty are not counted as members of the affiliate program for purposes of shared governance representation.

Faculty can be nominated for affiliate faculty status by a majority vote of the faculty in the affiliate program. All nominations for affiliate faculty status must be approved by the dean associated with the affiliate program.

#### Draft Language for Article 5.A.2.g

##### UW-Eau Claire – Barron County faculty

The tenure home for faculty at UW-Eau Claire – Barron County shall be the Barron County campus. UW-Eau Claire – Barron County faculty shall also be considered voting members of the UW-Eau Claire academic department most closely aligned with the faculty member's disciplinary expertise and shall have departmental participation and voting rights consistent with those afforded to affiliate faculty. UW-Eau Claire – Barron County faculty shall ~~also~~ be eligible to serve on University Senate, University Senate committees, and university-wide committees and councils in accordance with the membership rules for these bodies. UW-Eau Claire – Barron County faculty shall also be eligible to serve on ~~University Senate, University Senate and University-wide committees, and~~ college-wide committees as the representative from their affiliate department.
