

# Title IX

Sexual Misconduct is a violation of Title IX and includes sexual harassment, sexual assault, rape, stalking, dating violence, and domestic violence.

## What To Do And What To Know If You Have Been Subjected To Sexual Misconduct:

- You have the right to choose which resources you use, with whom you speak, what you say, and when you say it.
- You may seek medical attention with UW-Eau Claire Student Health Services or other medical facilities.
- You may report the sexual misconduct to the Title IX Coordinator, the Dean of Students, Housing Staff, or University Police.
- You have a right to speak with a confidential resource such as Health Services or Counseling Services.
- The university is required to take prompt action to end reported sexual misconduct, prevent its recurrence, and address its effects.
- The university is required to provide options for changing academic or living situations in certain cases of sexual misconduct.
- Retaliation for reporting sexual misconduct or helping with an investigation is prohibited.
