#### ADVISING TIPS

- If you intend to graduate in four years, you need to take a **minimum of 15 credits every semester.**
- **Try to take courses from all areas of your degree each semester**—(1) University/liberal Education (LE), (2) English major, and (3) minor/certificate—each semester; do NOT work to finish all your LE courses first.
- Complete your Foreign Language/Foreign Culture requirement early.
- **Consider tutoring in Center for Writing Excellence (Engl 397), a Writing Internship (Engl 498), and/or being an Academic Apprentice (Engl 394):** all are great ways to obtain professional experience, enhance your communication skills, fulfill your service learning, and build your resume.
- Use your Planner in CampS to plot out a four-year graduation plan
- Students may not pursue the Critical Studies certificate as their second program with an English Education Standard or English Education Comprehensive major for the purposes of graduation.
