If your answers to the above questions are "yes," we have an opportunity for you !

The National Science Foundation has funded summer research opportunities for undergraduate students from two-year campuses. Students will complete a 10-week, *fully funded*, summer research program, working in close collaboration with one or more faculty at UW-Eau Claire.

Summer research activities will begin on June 4, 2018 – August 10, 2018.

The program will provide a \$5,000 stipend to students, cover living costs while staying in the dorms at UW-Eau Claire, and can provide some assistance with travel expenses to conferences.

STEM students who belong to underrepresented minority groups from all degree programs are encouraged to apply to work with Science faculty at UW-Eau Claire in the areas of Biology, Chemistry, or Materials Science.

Simply download and fill out the attached application form and have a faculty member at your current institution complete a letter of recommendation on your behalf.

The deadline to receive all application materials is April 30, 2018, at 5:00 p.m.
