- Our website is getting an update! Thanks to our wonderful Communications Intern Liz.
- I had an opportunity to present to the bicycle and pedestrian safety committee about a potential partnership with SPIN on an e-scooter and e-bicycle share. The committee plans to discuss more



in depth the possibility at our next meeting, however for the time being - the committee's interest is peaked about making infrastructure changes to campus to make this program, an other forms of alternative forms of transportation a success.

- I had a chance to meet with a number of our partners in Facilities, Centers, and Dean Pierce to discuss a campus-wide composting initiative. It was established that campus-wide composting is attainable with two clear caveats, 1. We must have an educational training 2. All waste receptacles across campus need to be updated to provide consistent messaging. The good news is that we can take care of both of those things. Our partners over at IMC are currently constructing an EDI training for our Dean of Students Office. They've suggested that after they complete this training build, our team can utilize the template/skeleton for our own. This group of waste-savy individuals will meet again within the next month and provide updates, costs, and more information.
- Our collaboration with Innovation Labs regarding the Energy Dashboard is alive and well. Our Sustainability Analyst Tony Rongstad is currently the contact for Innovation Labs for all questions regarding data and conversions. More on this soon.
- We had a meeting with IMC this past week and have established a clear line of communication with IMC on a monthly basis.
