1            **WHEREAS, the Student Organization Commission allocates segregated**  
2            **fees through the student organization fund; and**

3            **WHEREAS, the full amount in the fund has been exhausted for the last four**  
4            **funding processes; and**

5            **WHEREAS, student organizations are expected to spend at least 90% of their**  
6            **allocation by the end of the fiscal year; and**

7            **WHEREAS, in the fiscal year of 2018-2019 over \$5,000 of funding was not used**  
8            **by student organizations by the June 30<sup>th</sup> deadline; and**

9            **WHEREAS, there are student organizations that can benefit from the excess**  
10           **funds for activities in the spring semester; and**

11           **WHEREAS, Student Senate has a responsibility to efficiently maintain and**  
12           **maximize student dollars; and**

13           **BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that upon passage of this bill, Student Senate**  
14           **will adopt the Student Organization Redistribution System in the Student Senate**  
15           **bylaws found in attachment A; and**

16           **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage, President Yates will transmit a**  
17           **copy of this bill to Dr. James Schmidt, Chancellor; LaRue Pierce, Dean of Students;**  
18           **Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine, Provost and Vice Chancellor, Academic Affairs; John**  
19           **Haven III, Vice Chancellor, Finance and Administration; Dr. Warren Anderson, Vice**
