Bowling**

Players & Player Equipment

- All players MUST wear bowling shoes.
- A team can consist of up to six (6) bowlers; a combination of only four (4) can bowl each game.
- Must have a minimum of three (3) bowlers present to start. Still allowed to bowl for individual points if less than three (3) but cannot bowl for team points.
- The first 6 bowlers to sign up are the only bowlers that can bowl.
- Once a bowler starts a game, he/she must finish or default that game.
- Once the teams start the 2nd frame, no other team members may enter until the next game.

Rules

Game, Field & Field Equipment - Game, Court, & Court Equipment

- Where: Wagners (2159 Brackett Ave)
- Cost: \$84.00 per team for the three (3) weeks. (includes shoes if needed).
- All money MUST be paid upfront, before play begins. Only credit/debit card will be accepted. NO REFUNDS!!!
- Winners of each division will receive an Intramural Champion T-shirt.

Length of Game & Time Constraints

- Each team will bowl three (3) games per night. Total team pin fall will count towards team total. The team with the greatest total pin count over the five-week period will be declared the winner.

- Intramural Championship t-shirts and glasses will be awarded to the team with the highest total pin fall over the five-week period.
- The championship team will also receive a free pizza and bowling part courtesy of Wagner's Lanes!
- There will also be a male and female individual champion that has the highest average throughout the season. To be eligible for the individual championship, a bowler must have bowled a minimum of ten (10) games throughout the season.
- Teams are not allowed to bowl extra games/frames. Any individual or team caught bowling extra games/frames will FORFEIT the night. Could be charged extra \$ for bowling extra frames.
- Anybody caught bowling for another player/team will forfeit the night.
- At the end of each game, fill out the BPA FORM for each bowler. At the end of each evening, sign the form and bring it to the supervisor. IF YOU DO NOT TURN THIS FORM IN YOU WILL NOT GET CREDIT FOR ANY SCORES FOR THE EVENING!!!
- Game time is forfeit time.

Player Conduct

Sportsmanship, Cards & Ejections

- Abusive or insulting language, acts of unfair play, and managers, coaches, or substitutes on the field of play will result in suspension.

ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION/BEHAVIOR

- Teams MUST keep all food and drinks out of the pits. If a team has to be repeatedly reminded, they will be asked to leave and FORFEIT their games for that night.
- Any individual or team that exhibits drunken behavior will be asked to leave and will FORFEIT all games bowled that night, removed from the league, and will have to see the intramural coordinator before he/she can participate in intramural activities.
- No outside (alcoholic) beverages can be brought in. This includes the team and its spectators. You will be held responsible for the night.
- No lofting or throwing of the bowling balls.
- Team conduct will be registered, by the officials, following the game, on a 1 to 6 scale.
- If a team does not have a 4 average on their team conduct, at the end of the regular season, they will not be allowed to play in the season ending all campus tournaments.
