Brief History of Issue - why the issue is being considered:

The Department of Art & Design requests the elimination of the Art, Printmaking, Comprehensive Major (Code 020-021), including the list of additional B.F.A requirements and note. The elimination of this program reflects the absence of this expertise in the department since resignations in recent years. The department will work with any existing students to complete their major but will no longer offer this option to students in the 2020-21 catalog and beyond.

Points Discussed by Committee:

1. Present or future utilization of print making equipment once major is eliminated.
2. Number of students impacted by elimination of the major.
3. Opportunities for existing students (if applicable) to complete major.
