Brief History of Issue - why the issue is being considered:

The Watershed Institute for Collaborative Environmental Studies requests approval to establish a new course prefix: (PH) Public Health. The Public Health Major was approved by University Senate during the Fall 2018 semester. The new prefix will be used initially for the following courses: Epidemiology, Disease Detective, US Health Systems and Policy, and Public Health Capstone. The PH prefix will also be used for a History of Public Health course currently in development as a cross-listed course with history.
