**BILL: ADOPTING THE 2020-2021 STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS FUND ALLOCATION
NUMBER 63-B-17 DATE: April 13, 2020

1 WHEREAS, the Student Organization Commission (SOC) oversees and allocates the Student
2 Organization Fund; and

3 WHEREAS, UW-Eau Claire students pay tuition and segregated fees that go towards
4 student organization activities; and

5 WHEREAS, SOC reviews each request and presentation for Segregated Fee Funding from
6 Recognized Student Organizations; and

7 WHEREAS, SOC follows the UW System Administrative Policy 820 for Segregated University
8 Fees; and

9 WHEREAS, SOC has completed its process of research, review, budget hearings, appellate
10 hearing, and deliberations upon which has adopted a proposal for the 2020-2021 Student
11 Organization Fund allocations; and

12 WHEREAS, the full amount of \$41,391 was exhausted in allocations to forty-one student
13 organizations; and

14 WHEREAS, the Finance Commission has accepted the SOC's proposal;

15 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, Student Senate officially approves of the full \$41,391 allocation
16 to student organizations; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon passage of this bill, Student Senate will adopt the
18 revised Student Organization Fund Allocations as seen in attachment A; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, any unused funds for the 2020/2021 school year will be utilized as
20 outlined in Section 8 of the SOC Bylaws; and

21 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage, President Johnson will transmit a copy of this bill
22 to Dr. James Schmidt, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Klein, Provost and Vice Chancellor, Academic Affairs; La
23 Rue Pierce, Dean of Students, John Haven, III, Vice Chancellor for Finance and Administration; Kristin
