

**UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-EAU CLAIRE  
STUDENT SENATE RESOLUTION**

**IN SUPPORT OF THE SPRING LEGISLATIVE PRIORITY SUMMARY**

1           WHEREAS, Chapter XV, Subchapter 2 of the University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire Student Senate  
2 bylaws require a Legislative Priority Summary be drafted; and

3           WHEREAS, Part 1, Section 2 of Subchapter 2 requires an updated Legislative Priority Summary  
4 be drafted for the spring semester; and

5           WHEREAS, the summary shall first be approved by the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission;  
6 and

7           WHEREAS, the summary shall then be approved by the full Senate at the next possible meeting;  
8 and

9           WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Affairs Commission approved the Legislative Priority Summary  
10 at its meeting on February 11, 2020; and

11           WHEREAS, the next Student Senate meeting after that passage is scheduled for February 17,  
12 2020.

13           BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, these policy positions are provided as the Spring Legislative Priority  
14 Summary (See Attachment “A”); and

15           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the University of Wisconsin – Eau Claire Student Senate supports this  
16 Legislative Priority Summary and adopts this as the official policy priorities of the University of Wisconsin  
17 – Eau Claire Student Senate; and

18           BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that upon passage of this resolution, President Johnson will transmit a
