WHEREAS, Student Senate Finance Commission adopted a new bylaw during the 2017-2018 school to 1 allow for student initiatives to be funded by segregated fees; and 2 3 WHEREAS, this bylaw may be found in CHAPTER XII, SUBCHAPTER 9, PART 6, Section 1: ORGANIZED 4 ACTIVITIES SPECIAL ALLOCATION ACCOUNT of the Student Senate Bylaws; and 5 WHEREAS, in 2019, students that identify as Latinx became the largest populations of students of 6 color at the University of Wisconsin - Eau Claire; and 7 WHEREAS, Latinx students expressed that a dedicated space would make them feel more connected 8 to the campus; and 9 WHEREAS, the Hibbard Hall Penthouse was dedicated to serve as the new Latinx Cultural Center this 10 year; and 11 WHEREAS, the Office of Multicultural Affairs created a two-phase plan to renovate the new Latinx 12 **Cultural Center; and** 13 WHEREAS, the Office of Multicultural Affairs requested funds to renovate the space during the first 14 phase; and 15 WHEREAS, this request would fund the renovations of walls, secure entry, and ventilation ducts; and 16 WHEREAS, the Student Senate Finance Commission received a presentation from the Director of the **17** Office of Multicultural Affairs at their weekly meeting on February 19, 2020; and 18 WHEREAS, Student Senate Finance Commission evaluated, exchanged ideas, deliberated and voted on 19 the student initiative; and 20 WHEREAS, Student Senate Finance Commission passed a motion to fund this initiative for the full 21 \$9,866; 22 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that upon passage, Senate Student will allocate \$9,688 to help fund 23 renovations for the Latinx Cultural Center; and 24 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President Johnson transmit a copy to Dr. James 25 Schmidt, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Klein, Provost and Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs; Dr. Warren 26 Anderson, Vice Chancellor, Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, and Student Affairs; Albert Colom, Vice 27 Chancellor, Enrollment Management; John Haven III, Vice Chancellor, Finance and Administration; Dr. 28 LaRue Pierce, Dean of Students; Evan Weiher, University Senate; Kristin Teresa O'Halloran, Director of 29
