Good evening all,

Happy March! I hope you all had a safe and relaxing weekend. Last week was a very busy one. Outside of my regular check ins with the directors, I participated in a University Planning Committee presentation to Centers staff, engaged in an Eau Claire Community Complex Annual Meeting and Update with Kim Way and other members of the Sonnentag Event Center team, and a CVTP leadership meeting. Vice President Murphy, Chief of Staff Luloff and I engaged in a student idea exchange with the national conference for undergraduate research 2023. We were able to identify strategies to get undergraduates engaged in conversations leading up to the conference. I met with Director Flottesmesch and Director Schilling to finalize the proposed constitutional amendments in 64-B-7. Vice President Murphy and I had a Sonnentag Communications Committee meeting as usual and finalized the presentation timeline. On Monday, March 15th, there will be a general presentation on Sonnentag to this body, followed by open forums and other discussions that week. We also had a check in with Jake Wrasse on the Wisconsin Capital budget update on the new proposals from Governor Evers and how we should proceed with the Rally for Excellence. I attended Blugold Friday with Blu, which was a success!

Today the Student Senate Executive Board engaged in a discussion with the Chancellor’s Executive Team on campus wide health initiatives in place of spring break, an update on the science building, planning for the return to campus for fall 2021, and priority registration. If you are interested in learning more, feel free to reach out to any member of the executive board! As many of you have seen, I sent out numerous meetings for the Rally for Excellence briefings before our week of rallying. Please review those, as our first large general meeting is tomorrow, Tuesday March 2nd, at 7PM. An agenda will be sent out by tomorrow morning. These meetings will be mandatory, so if you are not able to make it,



please let me know. I have my regular weekly meetings including Sonnentag, Rapid Response, and Eau Claire County Health check ins. I also have scheduled an open forum for my bill, 64-B-7 Constitutional Amendments to Include Emergency Procedures, Gender Inclusive Language and Land Acknowledgment. This will be from 4-6PM on Zoom on Thursday, March 4th. Per our bylaws, any Constitutional Ratification must have an open forum in between the first reading of the bill and the second. ITC has a lot going on, but I know we've got a busy night ahead of us, so I'll try and move fast.

Expect the laptop policy resolution at senate next week. Director Malik and I met with the Senate Technology Committee on Friday to gain additional feedback and we'll have it submitted for next week.

ITC voted in favor of increasing the FollowMe printing budget allocation from \$30,000 to a range of \$50,000-70,000 and increasing the printing allocation per student from \$10-20.

ITC also voted in favor of setting up the digital displays around the senate office which will cost around \$4,208.

We are also focusing on creating a formal process for taking in project proposals modeled after SOS's.

Director Schilling reached out with an idea for spending some of ITC's Innovative Program funds and that would be to purchase a Canva Pro license for the Communications Commission's graphic design intern. After bringing this up to ITC on Friday, we had the idea of possibly purchasing such a license for every graphic design intern. This upcoming week the commission will receive a presentation regarding City sustainability initiatives from Council member Jeremy Gragert.
