Explore domestic opportunities

If traveling overseas is not for you, there is plenty of adventure to be had through the National Student Exchange (NSE) program.

Alyson Simon experienced a semester at Montana State University where she discovered a passion for teaching, trail running, rock climbing and hiking. Upon returning home, Alyson was accepted into the education program.

Rachel Scott stepped out of her comfort zone to spend a semester at the University of New Mexico, where she was able to broaden her horizons as a geology major through field intensive geology courses.

Explore immersion opportunities

Through a one- to two-week Domestic Intercultural Immersion (DII) Experience led by UW-Eau Claire faculty and staff, you can explore a variety of multicultural communities located here in the U.S.

Natalie Hanson learned about the roles and impact of women during the civil rights movement as part of the Civil Rights Pilgrimage, an immersion that takes Blugolds to the South. They visit historic sites important to the civil rights movement, participate in slavery and Selma march re-enactments and talk with people who were part of the civil rights era's most influential and memorable events.

Connor Zielinski, an Eagan, Minnesota native, set out to learn more about and better understand the Somali community in Minneapolis. He spent a week volunteering in a predominately Somali school, talking with community leaders and activists, visiting Somali businesses and sampling local foods. This immersion experience helped him learn more about the Somali culture, traditions and religion.
