

TRANSFER COURSE EVALUATION GUIDE

Please read the enclosed material carefully and be sure to bring the Transfer Course Evaluation with you when you come to register. You will need this information when you confer with your advisor.

The following are codes that may appear on the Transfer Credit Report or the Student Transfer Evaluation and their explanations.

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| ELEC | Elective. No equivalent course at UWEC. Credit will be applied to the total credits needed to graduate. If ELEC is listed with a department or subject name, the credit may be applied to the major or minor. ELEC courses may be applied to the General Education requirement with the approval of the Dean of the School from which you intend to graduate. |
| CONSULT/ TRANS 100 | Credit will be granted. However, course equivalent needs to be determined by consultation with the appropriate department. Take your Transfer Course Evaluation and, if possible, a course outline or syllabus (including the title of the textbook used) and a copy of your school catalogue, to the appropriate UWEC department. |
| DEFER/ TRANS101 | Credit currently has not been awarded. Further course information is required to determine if course meets transfer eligibility. Take your Transfer Course Evaluation and, if possible, a course outline or syllabus (including the title of the textbook used) and a copy of your school catalogue to the appropriate UWEC department. There is a possibility you will not receive credit. |
| IP | Course in Progress – currently enrolled at another institution. The evaluation of “courses in progress” is tentative pending receipt of the final, OFFICIAL transcript. |
| O | The course has been recorded and the grade has been replaced (coded with TRPL), but credit has not been awarded. |
| TROA | The course has been recorded and is included in your transfer GPA, but credit has not been awarded. This may also be applied to courses that exceed the credit limit. Refer to the PLEASE NOTE section on credit limits. |
| TRPL | This course is the repeated course that replaces a previous course and grade (coded with O). Credit has been awarded for this course. |
| Blank Incoming Course | These courses are part of a “group” equivalency. This means that your incoming course is equivalent to more than one course at UW-Eau Claire. |
| Accepted | The status of Accepted means that this course is acceptable for transfer credit. |
| Rejected | The status of Rejected means that this course is not acceptable for transfer credit. |

PLEASE NOTE:

Junior College or Two-Year College Credits. A maximum of 72 semester credits earned in a junior college or two year college will be accepted as degree credit at UW-Eau Claire.

WTCS Credits (non-college parallel). Up to 72 credits general education coursework within the areas of communication skills, behavioral sciences, social sciences, mathematics, and natural sciences from a Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) institution leading to an applied associate degree may be considered for transfer. UW-Eau Claire may accept in transfer and apply on a course-by-course basis, occupational and technical coursework from WTCS programs leading to an applied associate degree.

Activity Credit (band, chorus, drama, etc.). Students may count a limited number of credits of kinesiology (physical education) activity courses toward graduation.

Credit by examination (example: CLEP or AP). You must provide the Office of Academic Testing (Schofield Hall, Room 226) with the original scores from the company. Scores recorded on a transcript are not acceptable.

Transfer credits will not be *officially* accepted until after you enroll. Appeal of the evaluation may be made though the Chair of the Department where the course resides.
