ON-CAMPUS DINING OPTIONS

All students who live in a residence hall are required to have an on-campus meal plan each semester and can choose from any of the three options below. The location of a student's residence hall does not determine which plan they select.

On-campus meal plans are selected through the Housing Portal. Students will be e-mailed details on how to sign-up for a plan before the beginning of each semester.

Students living in Aspenson Mogensen Hall, Chancellors Hall, Haymarket Landing and The Priory are exempt from this policy but may purchase a meal plan if they would like (see reverse).

GOLD FLEX MEAL PLAN

\$1,860 PER SEMESTER | ABOUT \$17.55 PER DAY

- 3 meal swipes per day, 7 days a week at Riverview Café in Hilltop Center on upper campus
- One 'Block Meal' per weekday that can be used at any dining location

BLU MEAL PLAN

\$1,700 PER SEMESTER | ABOUT \$16.05 PER DAY

Weekdays (Monday-Friday)

- 2 Block Meals per day that can be used on upper or lower campus

Weekends

(Friday beginning at 4 p.m., all day Saturday and Sunday until 8:30 p.m.)

- Unlimited access at Riverview Café in Hilltop Center on upper campus

LOYALTY DINING DOLLARS MEAL PLAN

\$1,370 PER SEMESTER | ABOUT \$12.90 PER DAY

- \$1,080 Meal Plan Dollars to be used at any campus dining location (upper or lower campus)

MEAL PLAN DOLLARS

Meal Plan Dollars can be used at any campus dining location during each semester. They are used as cash equivalent to make dining purchases, have no cash value, and expire at the end of the academic year.

If a student has an active on-campus meal plan both semesters, Meal Plan Dollar balances will roll over from fall to spring semester.

BLOCK MEALS

A block meal is a combination meal consisting of a pre-determined entree, side and beverage. Block meal menus rotate throughout each semester. Each dining location will have details on block meal offerings posted at their venue.

Examples of popular block meal options include:

- Premade sub sandwich or pb&j + chips or fruit + beverage
- Slice of pizza + cheese bread or fruit + beverage
- Pasta bake + garlic toast + beverage
- Burger + fries or fruit + beverage
- Chicken tenders + fries or fruit + beverage
- Stir fry daily entrée + beverage
- Omelet + hash browns or fruit + beverage
- Premade salad + yogurt or fruit + beverage

OFF-CAMPUS DINING OPTIONS

Students who live off-campus are not required to have a meal plan. Students living in Aspenson Mogensen Hall, Chancellors Hall, Haymarket Landing or The Priory are also exempt from having a meal plan, but they may select from one of the plans below if they choose.

Students living on-campus are required to have a meal plan (see reverse).

DINER'S CLUB

YOU SELECT THE AMOUNT PAYMENT DUE AT TIME OF PURCHASE

- 10% discount at The Dulany Inn in Davies Center and at Riverview Cafe in Hilltop Center
- Designated Bonus Days each semester to earn 10% in Bonus Dollars for every \$100 deposit
- Deposits can be made in person at Blugold Card Services or online through eAccounts
- Unused Diner's Club dollars do not expire until your relationship with the university ends

FLEX 50 PLAN

\$475 PAYMENT DUE AT TIME OF PURCHASE

- 50 Block Meals to be used in any dining facility on campus
- 50 Flex Dollars to be used in any dining facility on campus
- Purchased online through eAccounts
- Plan is available for use any time between the date of purchase and the end of the academic year
- No Flex 50 Plans will be sold after February 28
- Unused Block Meals and Flex 50 Dollars expire at the end of the academic year. No refunds will be issued for unused blocks or Flex 50 dollars.



AVAILABLE DINING LOCATIONS

Riverview Café: Main entrees, grill favorites, salad bar, pizza, pasta, Erbert & Gerbert's Deli and wraps, soup, Mexican favorites, beverages, and desserts.

Marketplace: Grill favorites, sandwiches, pasta, pizza, breakfast, sushi, stir fry, Erbert & Gerbert's Deli, and salad bar.

Einstein Brothers Bagels: Located in Centennial Hall. Serving freshly made bagels, sandwiches, and a variety of beverages.

The Cabin: Coffee shop proudly serving Starbuck's Coffee, grab-and go-items, and in-house baked goods.

Dulany Inn: On-campus restaurant featuring an all-you-can-eat buffet for lunch Monday-Friday.

Olson's Ice Cream: Locally made artisan-crafted ice cream, sorbet, and seasonal treats. All made with fresh milk, cream, and high-quality ingredients.

T-Store: Located in Towers Lobby. Convenience store offering a variety of snacks and beverages.

Just Baked Hot Food Kiosk: Located in Haas Fine Arts Building. Featuring hot meals such as burgers, calzones, pizza and desserts served from an automated kiosk.

Online Ordering through Everyday App: Includes all menus and delivery through the Kiwibot program. Can be used at any campus dining location.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

- As part of a campus-wide sustainability initiative, each student will participate in our BLUBOX re-usable container program. All students will be given a token for a BLUBOX container to use when dining in Marketplace and Riverview locations. When the container is returned, the student will get their token back so they can use it for their next meal. The cost of the first token is free. \$7 will be charged for each additional token in the event the BLUBOX container is not returned.
- All meal plans, except Diner's Club and the Flex 50 meal plans, include a \$290 non-refundable administrative fee which covers utilities, operational upkeep, food service equipment and supplies, furniture, cleaning and administrative salaries for all dining facilities.
- Additional Diner's Club deposits, and Flex 50 Meal Plan purchases can be made online through eAccounts.
- UW-Eau Claire reserves the right to change meal plan rates should costs increase more than anticipated at the time the original rates were established.
