Notes: Courses meet hybrid with the majority of classes remote synchronous and asynchronous online, with some on-campus meetings. Courses are scheduled on a weekly/block scheduled basis (1st yr: Monday, 2nd yr: Tuesday, 3rd yr: Wednesday).

All DNP courses have an additional per credit course fee. Students select a population focus (Adult-Gerontological or Family Health) and a role preparation (Administration/Nurse Executive). **The BSN-to-DNP Program can also be completed on a part-time (4 or 5 year) basis.**

Administration students are required to complete at least 7 credits of cognates. Administration role courses are offered on alternate years. Begin series on odd years (ie. 2025, 2027)

Clinical Hours: 1 clinical credit = 75 hours. Example: [6 (4,2) credits] = 6 credit course with 4 credits lecture/seminar/discussion and 2 credits clinical, requiring a minimum of 150 hours of clinical.

Admin = at least 69 credits (includes 7 credits of cognates). Clinical = 14 credits = 1050 hours.
