- All DNP courses have an additional per credit course fee.
- 1 clinical credit = 75 hours. Example: [6 (4,2) credits] = 6 credit course with 4 credits lecture/seminar/discussion and 2 credits clinical, requiring a minimum of 150 hours of clinical.

BSN-to-DNP Program can be completed on a Part-Time (4 or 5 year) Basis.

Clinical Hours: Advanced Clinical Practice (ACP), including PMHNP = 74 credits. Clinical = 16.5 credits (includes 704/708, 820, 893 and 894) = 1237.5 hours. (825 direct patient hours)
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
