What will transfer

University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UWEC) will transfer in any completed LE credits from Madison College, and most of the nursing program credits will be recognized as confirming credits. Students must complete a minimum of 30 credits of upper-level nursing courses at UWEC for the BSN Completion program.

GPA requirements to transfer

A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required in order to apply and be accepted to the BSN Completion program at UWEC.

When to Apply

Students may begin the application process at the beginning of their final semester of the CVTC Nursing-Associate Degree program. UWEC participates in the BSN@HOME collaboration program, which is a joint effort between seven of the University of Wisconsin System nursing programs. Applicants need to apply and be **admitted** to UWEC and the BSN Completion nursing program. All students must have a Wisconsin or Minnesota RN License at time of admission or by the designated deadline once admitted.
