## What will transfer

University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire (UWEC) will transfer in any completed LE credits from WITC and most of the nursing program credits. Students must complete a minimum of 30 credits of upper level nursing courses at UWEC for the BSN Completion program.

## **GPA** requirements to transfer

A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required in order to apply and be accepted to the BSN Completion program at UWEC.

#### When to Apply

Students may begin the application process at the beginning of their <u>final semester</u> of the WITC Nursing-Associate Degree program. UWEC participates in the BSN@HOME collaboration program, which is a joint effort between seven of the University of Wisconsin System nursing programs. Applicants will need to apply and be **admitted** to UWEC and the BSN Completion nursing program. All students must have a Wisconsin or Minnesota RN License at time of admission or by the designated deadline once admitted.
