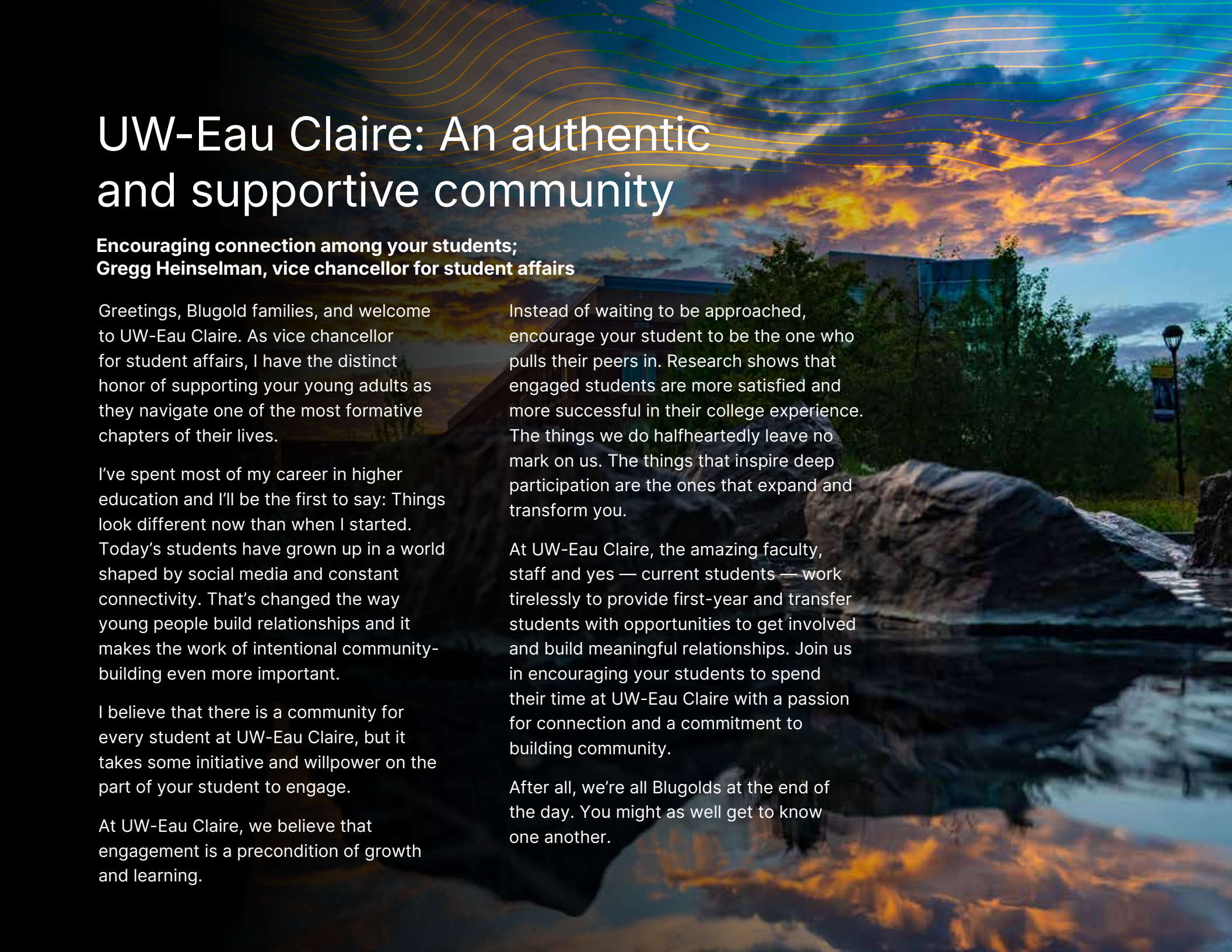
Welcome from Billy Felz, vice chancellor for enrollment management

Maybe the connections they made during the fall semester aren't as strong because they don't have a class with a friend they made, or perhaps they're realizing early on that one of their classes is going to really be a challenge for them. One way to encourage some consistency is through a part-time, on-campus job. We know that students who work on campus in their first year earn a GPA about .3 points higher than those who don't.
